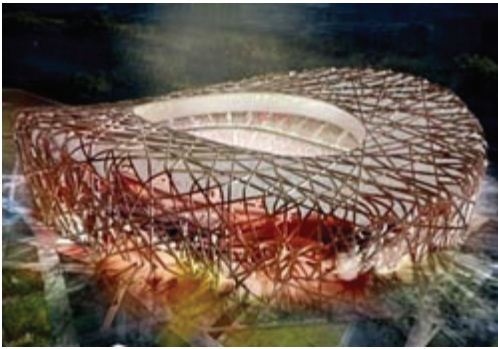


Beijing Olympic hotel to feature VingCard
